Summer camp is an option for children from all programs as well as children who are not currently enrolled at River Road.

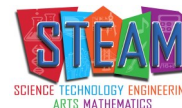

What is STEAM? Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Math! Join us for dinner, games, activities, music and more!



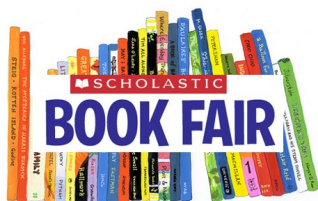
